



ADVANCED DIPLOMA OF PROJECT MANAGEMENT (AQF6) FOR PROGRAM MANAGERS - BSB60707

Course Overview

This course runs over 3 days beginning the 8th May and concluding the 10th May. The cost of the workshop inclusive of materials and final assessment \$3,000 (GST Free), the price also includes a light lunch.

Competencies

- Direct communications management of a project program - BSBPMG607A
- Direct risk management of a project program - BSBPMG608A
- Direct procurement and contracting for a project program - BSBPMG609A

Assessment

There is no formal examination in this course. Instead, participants demonstrate evidence of the required competencies and are assessed throughout the course. Assessment items consist of activities and exercises based on actual and simulated program management scenarios.

Prerequisites for Advanced Diploma

Participants need to have completed the Diploma of Project Management (BSB51407) or an equivalent level of qualification/accreditation and be currently working in a senior project environment and be able to access a work-based program involving a range of projects at the program manager level.

Who Should Attend

The Advanced Diploma is for you if you:

- Supervise others who develop project management plans
- Delegate responsibility for the achievement of project objectives to others
- Receive reports from several project managers
- Monitor and review a number of projects against business or corporate objectives

To successfully achieve the Advanced Diploma of Project Management, participants must:

- Complete a portfolio of work-based evidence and or attend an assessment interview
- Complete the assessment within six months of the completion of the workshop
